



## NEW RIVER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

### PUBLIC FACILITIES REPORT

- 1. The District owns and operates stormwater management facilities, some subdivision streets, street lights, a clubhouse and pool facility, and landscaping and irrigation throughout Sections 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 26 South, Range 20 East in Pasco County, Florida.

The current capacity of the District's facilities is not completely quantifiable, but the constructed facilities have been constructed in conformance with the community's design and construction permits with all facilities currently considered to be operating at acceptable levels. The final subdivision units within the community are still planned for the future and details are currently unavailable.

- 2. Provide a description of each public facility the district is building, improving, or expanding, or is currently proposing to build, improve, or expand within at least the next 7 years, including any facilities that the district is assisting another entity, except a local general-purpose government, to build, improve, or expand through a lease or other agreement with the district. For each public facility identified, describe how the district currently proposes to finance the facility.**

Subdivision infrastructure associated with the final phases of the development will be constructed in the future.

There are currently no plans to replace any District facilities within the next 10 years.

- 4. Provide the anticipated time the construction, improvement or expansion of each facility will be completed.**

Construction is anticipated to be complete within 5 years.

All public facilities have been/will be adequately sized for the District's needs, as part of the site design engineering.
